- 1. It is my responsibility to provide all learning materials needed for my homeschool program. My local public school district is **not** required to pay for or provide any educational materials.
- 2. I will provide instruction in the English language in the following subject areas: language arts, social science, mathematics, biological and physical sciences, fine arts, and physical development/health.
- 3. State law does not require me to keep attendance records, grades, completed assignments, tests, or any other records of my homeschool program. However, I accept responsibility for not keeping such records if asked to show proof of my child's education. Submitting this form is **not** proof that I have provided adequate homeschool education for the children listed above.
- 4. It is my responsibility to assess the children in my homeschool program and decide if they should advance to the next grade or graduate from high school. My local public school district is **not** required assess my student's academic progression or learning while they are being homeschooled.
- 5. It is my responsibility to create a transcript and diploma if my child graduates. My local public school will **not** review, sign, endorse, or in any way approve and issue a diploma to a student graduating from my homeschool program.
- 6. The coursework and grades completed in a homeschool program may or may not be accepted if my child re-enrolls in public school. As a result, my child may be required to retake courses or grades completed while being homeschooled.
